- Public Intakes consisted of 9 animals being returned from past adoption per agreement. Remaining 5 were requests for assistance from active fosters helping our organization
- Intakes within Target Community consisted of 55 animals from Santa Clara County Animal Care Services and 2 from VCA San Martin (local vet servicing the community)
- Intakes from Outside Target Community were animals abandoned at Petco Gilroy where FOSMAS is an adoption partner having an adoption center at that location
- Animal that died or were euthanized were for liver failure or FIP
